## Editorial,

Welcome to the 2018/2 issue of the International yearbook of Faculty of Security, Skopje. With every new issue the Faculty is continuing its primary objective, to be a place of academic and professional contest where the newest security issues are being debated, contested and brought about to the international scientific public. The Faculty of Security, Skopje is proud of gathering some of the most eminent researchers in the field of security sciences.

This issue brings 6 academic articles classified into original scientific, review and professional articles. Through the pages of this issue the reader will find articles related with variety of security topics such as conflict representation in media, social pathology of betting, usage of vetting in the context of security, methodics of research of explosions, resocialization of youth inmates in penitentiary facilities, as well as regionalism within the context of EU. Here, in this issue, we present you the articles and contributions of academic and professional researchers in security from different high educational security institutions and professional security entities in Macedonia.

The first article in this issue brings a fresh and inventive approach of conflict representation in media, specifically on film. The authors of the paper are Antoanela Petkovska, PhD, professor and Marija Dimitrievska, MA, demonstrator, both from the Institute of Sociology within the Faculty of Philosophy in Skopje. Within their paper, they analyze in detail the sociological aspects of cold war representation through the lenses of the former Yugoslavian movie. Through their subtle analysis they reveal the complex and tangled relations between the security, cultural and sociological aspects of media representation, so much inherent to the modern and postmodern sociological and securitological debates.

The second paper deals with the sociopathological aspects of betting. The paper is co-authorship of Pere Aslimoski, PhD, professor at the Faculty of Tourism and Hospitality in Ohrid and Saše Gerasimoski, PhD, professor at the Faculty of Security in Skopje. The authors of the paper elaborate the delicate sociopathological aspects of betting phenomena, with their sociological causes, consequences and societal reaction. They view betting as multifaceted phenomenon, with serious difficulties in defining, differentiating from gambling, as well as preventing both domestically and internationally.

The next paper, third in a row in this issue, deals with methodics of research of explosions. The authors of this paper are Goce Anakievski, PhD, from the Macedonian Army and Rose Smileski, PhD, professor at the Military Academy "General Mihailo Apostolski" in Skopje. Their paper is part of their research of explosions in the Republic of Macedonia within the period from 2006 to 2011, a research that was conducted in the firefight units. In their detail quantitative research they present interesting findings, analysis and comments related to the total number of explosions, number of explosions caused by deliberate act and by negligence in different facility and motor vehicles as well as number of injured persons and victims of explosions.

The fourth paper of this issue falls within the area of English for specific purposes. The author of the paper is Vesna Trajkovska, PhD, professor at the Faculty of Security in Skopje. Her paper focuses on the meaning of the Anglicism vetting (*ветинг*) within the context of security. The author has conducted a survey to determine the perceptions of students at the Faculty of Security in Skopje regarding this term. In conclusion, the author claims that although most of the students are familiar with the term vetting, the fact that most of the obtained answers were only partially acceptable points to the necessity of putting a greater emphasis on the term *ветинг* (*vetting*) in the English classroom.

The fifth paper examines the contradictions between the aims and possibilities for resocialization regarding the youth inmates in correctional penitentiary facilities. The author of the paper is Vesna Stefanovska, PhD, professor at the Faculty of Security in Skopje. The author's interest focuses on the specific features of the young convicted persons related to their developmental period and their impact on the imprisonment, the models of adaptation of the prison conditions, and the issue of distrust in the process of resocialization. The author concludes that in the years after the Second World War, despite the humanitarian dimension of the prison sentence, it failed to achieve the purpose for which this sentence was reformed.

This issue closes with the sixth paper by the author Katerina Klimoska, MSc and PhD student in International relations and conflict management. Her paper discusses the regionalism, with emphasis on the European project, i.e. European Union (EU). She gives an overview of regionalism and new regionalism and the way they are related with EU, both from political, as well as from security aspect. In the conclusion remarks, the author puts that the process of regionalism is constantly active and never finally set, especially within the EU framework.

The Editor of chief would like to thank all the contributors for their inspiring, interesting and quality articles and to express its hope that it would instigate further fruitful scientific and professional debates on key security issues of nowadays. At the same time, the Editor in chief would also like to extend his gratitude to the members of the Editorial board, reviewers and management of the Faculty of Security in Skopje, who helped this issue be published and thus continue almost four decades of issuing the oldest journal on security in Macedonia and one of the oldest in the region.
